## Billings Ovulation Method

- Clients are taught to observe external mucus and sensation at the vulva as biomarkers of fertility.
- The introductory session (free) is a general presentation given to a small group in person or online via video chat.
- Introductory session video links are available upon request for “self study” for clients unable to attend pre-scheduled group introductory sessions.
- Private, individualized follow-up sessions provide personal instruction on the use of the method, as well as complete chart review. Scheduled every two weeks for the first two months, with follow up chart reviews at regular intervals throughout the first year.
- Follow up sessions may be scheduled in person or via Skype.
- The practitioner is available for further follow up beyond the first year as needed, and for refresher courses following a change in life situation (i.e. postpartum, breastfeeding, perimenopause, etc.)
- The practitioner is also available for consultation between sessions, as needed.
- Flat fee of \$150 for all instruction and materials.

## Couple to Couple League (CCL)

- An international, interfaith, non-profit organization dedicated to teaching NFP to married and engaged couples.
- This class is taught by professionally trained and certified volunteer husband and wife teams.
- Teaches the sympto-thermal method of NFP which includes mucus, temperature and cervical changes. All of these symptoms, when crosschecked, provide a woman with a very accurate interpretation of her individual cycle and a full picture of fertility awareness.
- Classes consist of 3 sessions, usually spaced one month apart. Each class lasts approximately 2 hours, 15 minutes.
- Counseling is provided by any local teaching couple or by contacting CCL central headquarters directly.
- The fee for this course is \$140, which includes:
  - Personal chart review & consulting from Teaching Couple
  - Manual: The Art of Natural Family Planning® Student Guide
  - Digital basal thermometer
  - Chart booklet
  - One-year of CCL's award-winning magazine, Family Foundations
  - Book: Fertility, Cycles & Nutrition by Marilyn M. Shannon
- Couples who have previously been through the course and have an annual membership to CCL may also attend a refresher course and transition classes for postpartum and premenopause.

## Natural Family Planning International (NFPI)

**Natural Family Planning International**, a sympto-thermal method of NFP, provides high quality and low cost instruction about Natural Family Planning in the context of Christian discipleship and the moral teaching of the Catholic Church. The educational philosophy of this NFP organization is that engaged and married couples have a right to make well informed decisions about two distinct forms of NFP: ecological breastfeeding and systematic NFP. Ecological breastfeeding is a form of child care that normally spaces babies about two years apart on the average. Systematic NFP is a system that uses a woman's signs of fertility to determine the fertile and infertile times of her cycle.

**NFPI Instruction** is available in face-to-face courses taught by trained NFP teachers. Courses consist of 3 sessions, meeting on the 4th Sunday of each month in the series. Each session lasts 2.5 hrs. Cost is \$70 for 3 sessions. Website: [www.nfpandmore.org](http://www.nfpandmore.org)

## Creighton Model FertilityCare™ System

- Taught by practitioners who received their education and training through a program whose professional curriculum was developed at the Creighton University School of Medicine and the Pope Paul VI Institute for the Study of Human Reproduction, Omaha, Nebraska.
- Clients are taught to observe external mucus and patterns of dryness and bleeding.
- Focuses on individual reproductive situations with medical and health emphasis.
- Assists in the diagnosis and treatment of reproductive disorders (e.g. PMS, infertility, endometriosis, repetitive miscarriage, etc.)
- The introductory session is a general presentation given to a small group and introduces single women and couples to the use of the system.
- Private, individualized follow-up sessions provide personal instruction on the use of the method, as well as complete chart review. Scheduled every 2 weeks for the first two months, and then at regular intervals throughout the first year.
- Subsequent follow-ups recommended every six to twelve months as needed.
- The practitioner is also available for consultation between sessions, as needed

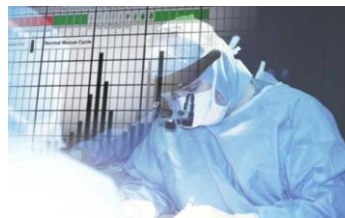
