

Catholic Radio in S.C.

With many churches required to cancel masses, Catholic Radio in South Carolina continues to offer listeners an imperfect, but readily available, alternative.

On our stations, we broadcast Mass from the EWTN Chapel every morning beginning at 8 a.m., including Saturday and Sunday.

Listeners can access our broadcast at WCKI 1300 AM in the Upstate; WLTQ 730 AM in the Coastal area; and on the NEW FM in Charleston, W294CJ 106.7 FM.

While these broadcasts are not intended to replace or fulfill a Sunday obligation, given the current, temporary dispensation from that obligation, it may be helpful to listen to the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass as a means to participate in spirit.
