Statement from Bishop Robert E. Guglielmo regarding the Supreme Court's Decision on DACA

CHARLESTON, SC – The Most Reverend Robert E. Guglielmo, Bishop of Charleston, released the below statement in response to the Supreme Court's opinion on the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program.

“I, along with the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), welcome the Supreme Court's decision on DACA. The DACA youth in South Carolina deserve to stay here, in the place that is their one and only home.

“To the DACA youth, the Catholic Diocese of Charleston will continue to support you and your families. Thank you for all you have done and will do to contribute to our community and our Church family.

“I join with the USCCB in calling upon our elected officials to move forward in a bipartisan manner and find a permanent legislative solution to provide a path to citizenship for Dreamers so they can remain in the United States and continue to reach their God-given potential.”
