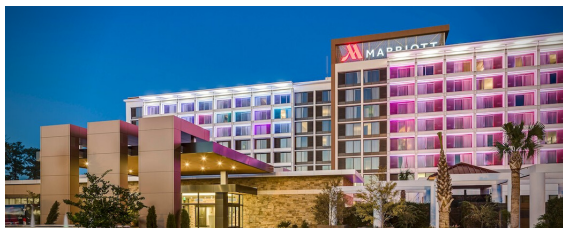

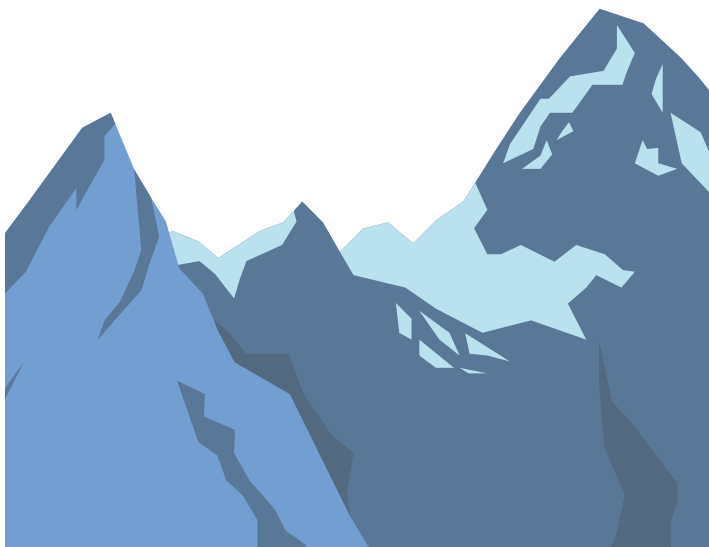

Rev. Joe Creedon



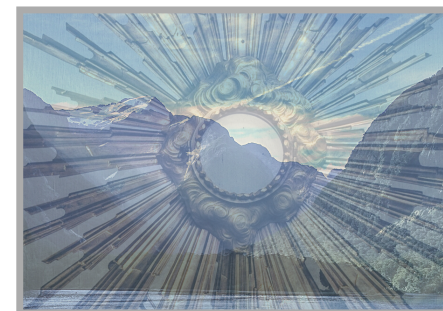

In retirement, he has been a sought after speaker on the spirituality of stewardship, and enjoys giving parish missions and stewardship workshops.
