Walking with Moms in Need

The Catholic Church has a rich history in helping women with unplanned pregnancies so it is no surprise that we would embrace Walking With Moms In Need.

Archbishop Joseph Naumann of Kansas City, who spearheaded the launch of the initiative as past chair of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops Committee on Pro-Life Activities, said **the goal is to identify gaps or areas with insufficient resources.**

"... then to take concrete steps to expand the help available to mothers, not only during the pregnancy but for months and even years after the child's birth," he said.

Natural Family Planning is not contraception; it is true family planning. By respecting the love-giving and life-giving nature of marriage, NFP enriches the bond between husband and wife.




AT THE POLLS
