WHY: St. Clare's Home opened in August of 2021 and is operated by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Charleston. It houses, cares for, and educates expectant mothers who are in need of shelter and safety. Since opening, eight babies have been born, plus 17 women and their children have been assisted at the home.

Melissa Ohden, founder and CEO of the Abortion Survivors Network, is the featured speaker. Ohden survived a saline abortion attempt at seven months gestation and is now a nationally recognized speaker and author.
