Mike Patin — the “Engagin’ Cajun” — uses energy, humor and stories to remind people of God’s presence among us while inviting others (and himself) to take the “next step” in our journey with God.

In 1984, his ministry career began as a high school teacher and coach. He then moved to diocesan youth ministry in New Orleans for 13 years.

Since 2003, he has been a full-time speaker and “faith horticulturist.” He has engaged groups from 10 to 23,000 in over 130 U.S. and Canadian dioceses, speaking at parish missions, conferences/rallies, retreats, and in-services.

His audiences have included youth, adults, families, clergy and seminarians, faculties, businesses, athletic teams and hospital staffs.

Beautiful Camp St. Christopher is right on the beach on Seabrook Island. Be nourished and recharged by our retreat leader each morning, and in the afternoon walk along the shore and enjoy a beautiful sunset; fish on the camp’s private dock; or lay on the beach and listen to the waves come ashore. When is it and what does it cost?

It begins Monday, May 8, 2023 at 12 p.m. with lunch, and concludes at 11 a.m. on Thursday, May 11, 2023.

Attending single is \$345 per person; double occupancy is \$265 per person. A \$100 deposit reserves your spot; limited scholarships are available.
